We have a lot of exciting things planned for the month of May. As you know, the Village has their annual Multi Block Rummage Sale on the first Saturday in May, which is May 2nd this year. I hope everyone is able to participate. The Zoning Ordinance 08-2, prohibits signs from being placed on poles and along the streets. For this special event, Village Residents will be allowed to put signs out for their sales. All signs must be removed by Sunday evening.


On Monday, May 4th and Tuesday, May 5th will be May Clean-Up. If anyone wants to get a head start with the clean up, Union Township Trustees will have their Clean-up on Saturday, May 2nd from 9 to 3 and their dumpsters will be located at their work site on old Coryville Road, take the next left after you go through the red light at Bradrick and their site is on the right. Our dumpster will be at the same location this year as it has been in the past; on Grant Street across from Snow Biz. We will have a dumpster delivered on Monday morning and when it is full it will be changed out and when the 2nd dumpster is full that will be it for that day. On Tuesday when the dumpster is full there will not be another one. We are prohibited from taking paint cans, tires, batteries and large pieces of furniture. This is the perfect opportunity to get rid of any junk you may have piling up.

I am very proud to announce that the Village will be making improvements to the Park on Wilgus Street on Saturday, May 9th. We are asking for volunteers who would like to help spruce up the park with fresh paint and new equipment. The Village will have supplies on hand for you to use but you may want to bring a 4 inch roller and be sure to wear old clothes. All volunteers will be treated to hot dogs, hamburgers and drinks.

I would like to remind everyone to please take the time to blow your grass off the sidewalk and street when mowing. We will be making this part of our current weed ordinance 05-4 soon. Violators will be cited. I have been working very hard along with Village Council and employees to get our town cleaned- up and looking nice. Please take 5 minutes to mow out front of your property, if you have grass.

I want to remind everyone to put their trash cans up after your trash has been collected and do not bring them out except the night before pick up. Please do not put tree limbs out on Village property, we do not have any way of disposing of them. I know that if we all work together we can make our town something to be proud of.
